### EXPOSITION AND EUCHARISTIC ADORATION IN OUR PARISH

THE LORD IS HERE; HE IS ASKING FOR YOU! (Jn 11:28) Pope St. John Paul II says that, 'At the centre of the Church is the Eucharist, where Christ is present and active in humanity and in the whole world by means of the Holy Spirit. One trembles at the claim of this same Pope that, 'in that little Host is the solution to all the problems of the world'. Yet, everything points to the veracity of the assertion. In any case, the words of this saint, as well as the words of the many holy people, past and present, are only footnotes to the timeless truth from Jesus Christ - the Eucharistic Lord. In Mark 14:22-24, we read, 'While they were at supper, He took some bread, and after a blessing He broke it, and gave it to them, and said, "Take it; this is My body." And when He had taken a cup and given thanks, He gave it to them, and they all drank from it. And He said to them, "This is My blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many". In John 6:51, the Lord says, "I am the living bread that came down out of heaven; if anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread also which I will give for the life of the world is My flesh."

One of the accounts from the early Church, Acts 2:46-47, reports that, 'Day by day continuing with one mind in the temple, and breaking bread, they were...with gladness and sincerity of heart, praising God and having favour with all the people. And the Lord was adding to their number day by day those who were being saved.

We need this experience in our parish. We are having the adoration of the Lord in the Eucharist for the next 9 days (July 21-29). The time is 5.00pm to 6.00pm. Subsequently, we shall have it every Friday from 5.00pm to 6.00pm. We cannot exhaust the blessings that will be 'unleashed' on us as a family, as a community and as a Church. The Lord is here. He is asking for you! (Jn 11:28)
